

Swimming Pool Rules

Pool Opens: 1st week of May

Pool Closes: 1st week of October

NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY – use of the facility is at your own risk.

- Premises are to be used ONLY by Residents of The Courtyards and guests in the company of Residents.
- Each residence has a key that will open the gate to the pool.
- Hours of operation are 8:00 am to 8:00 pm.
- The premises must be available to all Residents at all times.
- Gatherings of more than 5 guests must be approved in advance by the Board.
 - Teen parties must be chaperoned by a resident adult.
 - Formal parties require an advance deposit (to be defaulted for cause) from the sponsoring Resident to make certain the premises are left in a good, clean, neat, and orderly condition.
 - If a party is approved it does not allow exclusive use of the pool.
- Children under 14 years old must be accompanied by a Resident adult.
- Babies and toddlers should wear swim diapers.
- Be considerate of others – keep the premises clean, neat and orderly – place all litter in trash receptacles.
- Do not bring any glass or other breakables into the pool area.
- Consumption of alcoholic beverages by anyone under 21 years old is prohibited.
- Smoking is prohibited in the pool area.
- No eating or drinking while in the pool.
- No grills are allowed in the pool area.
- No ball or Frisbee throwing allowed.
- No running, pushing, jumping or rough play is allowed.
- No diving allowed.
- A towel must be placed on pool furniture when used.
- Umbrellas should be lowered after use.
- No furniture may be removed from the fenced area.
- No radios, etc., may be used without earphones. Exceptions may be made for formal parties.
- No pets allowed.
- Pool equipment room is off limits. No tampering with valves.
- Gate must be closed when premises are not in use. Last to leave is responsible for closing.
- IN CASE OF EMERGENCY, CALL 911 using the special purpose RED PHONE.
